2. Computer Literacy – *Vinh Phan*

Removing the computer literacy requirement. Currently, here are some courses that fulfill the requirement: CIS 1, CIS 223A, CIS 233, LRNRE 211, BUS 24, BIOL 31. Each program can still have this requirement in their degree. Specific language in the graduation requirement describes the requirement as “A broad understanding of computer concepts.”
