### How Can I Teach A Course Online?

#### Curriculum

- First, express your interest in teaching an online course to your department chair and have a discussion about the department's course offerings and needs. Your department chair can confirm if the course outline of record already has an approved distance education addendum.
- If it does not, you will need to work with your department chair to complete a
  distance education addendum and submit it to Curriculum Committee for
  approval.

Review Peralta Administrative Procedure <u>AP 4105</u> regarding distance education. Recommended training preparation includes:

- @ONE the Online Network of Educators courses.
- <u>EDT Courses</u> offered through Merritt College.
- The PCCD Online Equity Training course.


## **Distance Education Coordinator Office Hours**
