## New Canvas Features

- *Gender Pronouns:* Canvas now allows users to display preferred pronouns! To access this feature, click on "Account" on the left-hand column and then "Settings." From there, you'll see a "pronouns" setting to adjust. Here's [a link with detailed instructions](#).
