

# HOW TO CALCULATE YOUR GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)

The cumulative GPA is computed by dividing the total number of units a student has attempted into the total number of grade points the student has earned:

$$\frac{\text{Total Grade Points}}{\text{Total Semester Units Attempted}} = \text{Grade Point Average (GPA)}$$

<u>Letter Grade Value</u>	=	<u>Point Value</u>
A	=	4.0
B	=	3.0
C	=	2.0
D	=	1.0
F	=	0

## Non-Letter Grades

W	MW
EW	I
P	NP
IP	RD

These non-letter grades have no point value and are not counted in units attempted when calculating your GPA.

## Time to Calculate Your GPA!

<u>Course</u>	<u>Grade</u>	<u>Points</u>	<u>Attempted</u>	<u>Completed</u>	<u>Grade Points X Attempted</u>
English 1A	B	3	4 units	4 units	$3 \times 4 = 12$ points
Math 13	A	4	4 units	4 units	$4 \times 4 = 16$ points
Music 10	P	0	0 units	0 units	$0 \times 0 = 0$ points
Biol 10	C	2	4 units	4 units	$2 \times 4 = 8$ points
Hist 7A	W	0	0 units	3 units	$0 \times 0 = 0$ points
Psych 1A	F	0	3 units	0 units	$0 \times 3 = 0$ points
			<u>15 units</u>		<u>36 grade points earned</u>

$$\frac{\text{36 grade points earned}}{\text{15 semester units attempted}} = \text{2.40 GPA}$$
