This work must be documented in CurriQnet and must be authentic (as described in the SLO assessment rubric). *Adjunct faculty are eligible to receive 1 stipend per course they teach that they assess regardless of the number of SLO's per course that have been assessed and a maximum of \$300 per academic year.*
