# Course Prep Tips



## Equity & Accessibility

## Establish Early Student Contact

Early communication with students sets the stage for positive student-instructor interaction. A welcome email or letter is a simple way to connect with students before the course begins. Another option is to publish all or portions of your course *before* the first day of class so students can get familiar with you and the course.

## Verify Start & End Dates

By default, students see courses in a read-only format *before* the first official day of class. This means students cannot submit assignments, post discussions, upload files, or take part in any action-based tasks other than read content before the first official day of the class. However, as an instructor, you may need to alter the participation start or end date to suit your instructional needs.
